

SDE Safety and Stable Conduct Rules

Owners hereby acknowledges receipt and understanding of the current STABLE Rules, which are incorporated by reference in full, as if fully set forth herein. OWNER agrees he and his guests and invitees will be bound and abide by these Rules, and accepts responsibility for the conduct of his guests and invitees according to these Rules. OWNER acknowledges the Rules include but are not limited to:

STABLE Conduct Rules: Be Nice!!

- A. No tobacco or alcohol use will be allowed on property.
- B. No profanity.
- C. Stall and Tack area signs need to be approved by STABLE.
- D. No exposed cleavage or uncovered keisters.
- E. No unnecessary aggressive behavior with any horse.

SAFETY Rules: Be Smart!!

- A. All riding and horse handling is done at your own risk!
- B. OWNERS are responsible for the safety of their guest.
- C. No off leash dogs or excessive barking allowed.
- D. Closed toed shoes are required be all boarders and their guests.
- E. Equine approved helmets are required for all minors and when jumping.
- F. Children under the age of 13 are to be under adult supervision at all times.
- G. No running, yelling or boisterous play, especially when horses are present.
- H. DO NOT FEED, RIDE, HANDLE OR MEDICATE ANOTHER BOARDER'S HORSE WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THAT HORSE'S OWNER PROVIDED TO MANAGEMENT.
- I. Halters are to be taken off of horses when turned out into paddocks or in stalls. Please put your horse back in **their** designated area. Any pasture or paddock changes are to be done by the stables owners and employees only. All horses should have their halter and lead rope hanging on their stalls when inside for quick access during emergencies.
- J. All owners and riders need to pick up after their horses. Manure needs to be placed in muck bins and hair, mud from feet etc. placed in the trash bins.
- K. Please make sure all personal items and tack, brushes, saddles etc are kept organized.
- L. The arena is used on a first come first serve basis. Everyone can co-exist and use at once but be respectful of who is around (children etc).
- M. Any loss of equipment is not the responsibility of STABLE, its owners or employees. If you are found to be stealing, you and your horse(s) will be removed from the property immediately.
- N. Trailers are stored at OWNERS on risk. Any damages to trailers being stored at STABLE are not the responsibility of STABLE, its owners or employees.
- O. All gates and stall doors are to be kept shut and secured.
- P. No riding in the parking lot.
- Q. Be accountable; if you are riding alone tell someone when, where and for how long you are riding.
- R. Only tie horses in designated area. OWNERS are responsible for damages by their horses while being tied up. Including chewing or kicking on the area wall
- S. OWNER is not allowed to leave the property unless their horse is in a designated area.
- T. All participating minors will be required to submit current participation and release forms.

Failure to adhere to safety and conduct rules may result in expulsion or in extreme cases eviction.
